FDA Approves Veltin Gel for the Treatment of Acne Vulgaris

Stiefel, a GSK company, announced the US Food and Drug Administration approval of Veltin (clindamycin phosphate and tretinoin) gel for the topical treatment of acne vulgaris in patients aged 12 years and older on July 16, 2010. Veltin gel combines a topical retinoid and an antibiotic into one topical treatment. The waterbased gel has a fixed combination of 2 solubilized active ingredients, tretinoin and clindamycin phosphate. A clinical trial of 1649 patients showed that Veltin gel was more effective in achieving clearer skin than tretinoin gel or clindamycin phosphate gel alone. Veltin gel is not indicated for patients who have Crohns disease, ulcerative colitis, or have developed colitis with past antibiotic use, because clindamycin can cause severe colitis. Patients using Veltin gel also should avoid exposure to sunlight, sun lamps, and weather extremes. Local adverse reactions included dryness, irritation, exfoliation, erythema, pruritus, and dermatitis. Stiefel plans to make the medicine available for prescription later this year.
