- In the article “A Multicenter, Open-Label Study of the Efficacy and Safety of Ciclopirox Nail Lacquer Solution 8% for the Treatment of Onychomycosis in Patients With Diabetes” by Claus Seebacher, MD, et al, the Comment section on page 21 states “Treatment with ciclopirox nail lacquer reduced the affected nail area by 36% at the interim assessment and 60% at the final assessment, when compared with baseline assessments.” These values were presented in error, and the correct statement should read “Treatment with ciclopirox nail lacquer reduced the median affected nail area by 41% at the interim assessment and 75% at the final assessment.”
