

## Immunobullous Skin Conditions

Diagnosis	Antigen (Weight, kDa)	Other
BP	BPAg1 (230), NC16A domain of BPAg2 (180)	BPAg2=BP180=collagen XVII; linear IgG and C3 at DEJ on DIF; epidermal staining on salt-split skin
Cicatricial pemphigoid (mucous membrane pemphigoid or benign mucosal pemphigoid)	C terminal of BPAg2 (180), laminin-5, BPAg1 (230)	Oral involvement most common; laminin-5=laminin-332=epiligrin; linear IgG and C3 at DEJ on DIF
Ocular cicatricial pemphigoid	$\beta 4$ subunit of $\alpha 6\beta 4$ integrin (200)	Linear IgG and C3 at DEJ on DIF
Lichen planus pemphigoides	BPAg2 (180)	Linear IgG and C3 at DEJ on DIF
Pemphigoid gestationis	BPAg2 (180)	Sometimes BPAg1; linear IgG and C3 at DEJ on DIF
Pemphigus vulgaris	Dsg3 (130), Dsg1 (160)	Dsg3 (mucosal); Dsg1 (cutaneous); intercellular IgG on DIF; IIF using monkey esophagus
Paraneoplastic pemphigus	Dsg3 (130), Dsg1 (160), plectin (500), desmoplakin I (250), desmoplakin II (210), BPAg1 (230), envoplakin (210), periplakin (190)	Common associations include (in order of frequency) NHL, CLL, Castleman disease, thymomas; IgG intercellular and linear at DEJ on DIF; IIF using rat bladder
Pemphigus foliaceus	Dsg1 (160)	Fogo selvagem endemic in Brazil, vector <i>Simulium</i> black fly; intercellular IgG on DIF; IIF using guinea pig esophagus
IgA pemphigus	Desmocollin (100–110)	IEN, SPD; intercellular IgA on DIF
Pemphigus vegetans	Dsg3 (130), Dsg1 (160)	Neumann disease (severe); Hallopeau disease (milder); intercellular IgG on DIF
Pemphigus erythematosus (Senear-Usher syndrome)	Dsg1 (160)	Lupus and pemphigus foliaceus overlap; IgG intercellular and linear at DEJ on DIF
Chronic bullous dermatosis of childhood	BPAg2 LAD-1 (97)	Linear IgA at DEJ on DIF
LAD	BPAg2 LAD-1 (97)	Vancomycin can be a drug-induced cause; linear IgA at DEJ on DIF
Dermatitis herpetiformis	Epidermal transglutaminase 3 (77)	Antiendomysial and antigliadin antibodies; granular IgA in dermal papillae on DIF
Epidermolysis bullosa acquisita	Collagen VII (290)	Linear IgG at DEJ on DIF; dermal staining on salt-split skin
Bullous eruption of systemic lupus erythematosus	Collagen VII (290)	Linear IgG at DEJ on DIF; dermal staining on salt-split skin
