

# A Conversion Code from the RCGP to the ICHPPC Classification System

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Faculty members from four family medicine training programs participated in the production of a definitive conversion of the Royal College of General Practitioners Classification of Diseases as modified for use with problem-oriented medical records (RCGP) to the International Classification of Health Problems for Primary Care (ICHPPC). The method used to produce the conversion and the several problems encountered are described. A detailed translation with the appropriate ICHPPC equivalent for each RCGP diagnostic title and code number is provided.

The Royal College of General Practitioners Classification of Diseases was first established in the 1950s and its modification for use with problem-oriented medical records (RCGP) was introduced into the United States in 1970 (RCGP-US). Since then it has been used to classify morbidity in numerous ambulatory care settings including practices associated with family medicine training programs. The most extensive report using morbidity data generated by the RCGP classification was that emanating from the Medical College of Virginia.<sup>1</sup> Although there was no frank discontent with the

RCGP-US classification at that time, there was a growing feeling that a simpler, international classification specifically designed for use within the primary care setting would be desirable. Thus, the International Classification of Health Problems in Primary Care (ICHPPC) was developed by the World Organization of National Colleges and Academies of General Practice/Family Medicine (WONCA).<sup>\*</sup> Its historical background and the description of its field trials have been reported elsewhere.<sup>2,3</sup> Several primary care centers have adopted ICHPPC as their initial classification system, and others, who had previously used the RCGP classification have found it beneficial to convert to ICHPPC. This communication details the advantages as well as some of the problems involved in such a conversion.

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## Procedure

Faculty members of four family medicine training programs were chosen to independently produce a diagnostic title conversion from the RCGP to the ICHPPC. When the four preliminary translations were considered together there was concern over the subtleties of conversion of several diagnostic titles. By discussion and reference to the International Classification of Diseases-Eighth Revision (ICD-8 and ICDA-8) mutually agreeable titles were established. Although the RCGP classification contains more diagnostic titles than does the ICHPPC, the faculty committee attempted to maintain specificity whenever possible. Precise translation of one diagnostic classification into another is impossible. The conversion of existing morbidity data files or the comparison of data collected using the RCGP with morbidity data from ICHPPC-generated studies must therefore proceed with caution and with a full understanding of the construction of each classification.

## Specific Modification Items

RCGP contains 22 categories with 628 diagnostic titles compared with the ICHPPC's 18 categories and 371 diagnostic titles (Table 1). RCGP Category 18, "Prophylactic Procedures," Category 20, "Psychosocial and Family Problems," and Category 22, "Selected Drug Index" have been condensed into ICHPPC "Supplementary Classification," which is Category 18. Each RCGP category except Category 22, "Selected Drug Index," contains the residual title, "Other Sign, Symptom, or Incomplete Diagnosis." Most of these rubrics have been transferred to the single ICHPPC Category 16, "Physical Signs, Symptoms, and Ill-Defined Conditions Not Otherwise Specified or Not Yet Diagnosed." This means that comparison of aggregate category data, although infrequently used, is less easily accomplished than comparison of specific problem items.

RCGP Category 21, "Family History of Selected Diseases," has been deleted in conversion; however, family history information is maintained by a

parallel classification with a modifying letter as below:

ICHPPC

315 - Mental retardation

F315 - Family history of mental retardation

The entire RCGP Category 22, "Selected Drug Index," is translated to the ICHPPC diagnostic title, Y16 - "Observation and Care of Patients on High Risk Medication," with the exception of RCGP number 585, "Birth Control Pills," which converts to ICHPPC Y41-.

At the level of specific diagnostic titles there are additional differences which warrant description. As shown in Table 2, several diagnostic titles from RCGP are combined into a single

title in ICHPPC. Conversely, in other instances (see Table 3), a single rubric from RCGP has been expanded to several rubrics in ICHPPC. In most of the latter instances we preferred the "Other Diseases" rubric.

The importance of ICHPPC as a new international classification for primary care physicians cannot be underestimated. It has been produced under the auspices of the World Organization of National Colleges and Academies of General Practice/Family Medicine (WONCA) and is endorsed by the North American Primary Care Research Group (NAPCRG) and by the Central Office of the International Classification of Diseases-Adapted (ICDA). The classification will receive

widespread use in numerous and diverse ambulatory care settings. Although problems are inevitable with conversion from one classification to another, the authors strongly recommend this change and are, therefore, presenting this detailed rubric-by-rubric conversion table to facilitate the change from RCGP to ICHPPC.
