

A Conversion Code from ICHPPC-1 to ICHPPC-2

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Faculty members from four departments of family medicine participated in the production of a definitive conversion from the first to the second versions of the International Classification of Health Problems in Primary Care (ICHPPC). A detailed conversion code with the appropriate ICHPPC-2 equivalent for each ICHPPC-1 diagnostic title is provided. Differences between the two classifications are discussed and suggestions are made for the use of the conversion code.

Publication of the International Classification of Health Problems in Primary Care (ICHPPC-1) in 1975¹ was an important milestone for primary care research. This classification, developed by primary care physicians for use in ambulatory settings, rapidly gained wide acceptance throughout the world. The recently published second version (ICHPPC-2)² has the additional advantage of approval by the World Health Organization as an official adaptation of the ninth revision of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD). It is anticipated that those primary care practices which in the past collected morbidity data using ICHPPC-1 will make the necessary changes to col-

lect similar data using this second version of the classification. Those who make this conversion will encounter problems when attempting to compare data collected with ICHPPC-1 to those collected using the new version or when attempting to pool data collected with both the old and new versions. The purpose of this paper is to indicate some of these problems and to present a suggested code to be used for this conversion.

Methods

Several of the authors working independently produced first drafts of a conversion code. This was done by comparing each ICHPPC-1 rubric with the corresponding rubric from ICHPPC-2 and by referring, when necessary, to the eighth and ninth revisions of ICD.^{3,4} The task was simplified because the authors of ICHPPC-2 attempted to make the position numbers in the new classification correspond with those in the old. They also indicated which rubrics had been changed. These several drafts were compared and the differences between them discussed. The agreed-to joint draft was circulated to all authors for careful scrutiny, comments, and corrections. The final conversion code is presented in Table 1.

Discussion

The authors of ICHPPC-2 attempted to maintain the same basic structure as found in the original classification, making as few changes as possible while adapting the classification to make it compatible with ICD-9. As a result, 241 (65 percent) of the 371 ICHPPC-1 rubrics are completely unchanged. Most changes in the other 130 rubrics are slight and affect only a small percentage of the problems seen in ambulatory practice. Where these changes exist, an attempt was made to

choose the ICHPPC-2 rubric most likely to contain the majority of health problems recorded using the original ICHPPC-1 diagnostic title. A lack of exact correspondence between a rubric in ICHPPC-1 and the corresponding rubric in ICHPPC-2 can arise in several ways.

1. A number of health problems which were grouped together in ICHPPC-1 may be dispersed among two or more rubrics in ICHPPC-2. The opposite situation may also occur. Examples of this type are given in Table 2.

2. In some instances, health problems were

grouped differently in the two classifications (Table 3).

3. In several instances, two ICHPPC-1 rubrics have been combined to form a single ICHPPC-2 rubric (Table 4).

4. Some rubrics from ICHPPC-2 do not have an equivalent in ICHPPC-1 and therefore are not listed in this transfer code. These will, therefore, have no entries from data collected prior to the implementation of ICHPPC-2 (Table 5).

5. Seven new position numbers appear in ICHPPC-2 (positions 372 through 378). Sixteen position numbers have been dropped from the classification, usually by combining two positions in ICHPPC-1 into a single position in ICHPPC-2. Thus, the total number of rubrics in the new classification is 362.

There are many ways in which this conversion code may be applied. The authors suggest that each practice apply the code to one copy of all

data collected in the past using ICHPPC-1. This will allow previously collected diagnostic data to be combined with newly collected data using ICHPPC-2 and longitudinally analyzed as if all data had been collected using the new classification. For diagnoses listed under the 241 rubrics with exact correspondence, no distortion will result from the use of this transfer code. For rubrics with asterisks in the right-hand column of Table 1, there may be an increase or decrease in frequency noted at the time of transition to full use of ICHPPC-2. Reasons for these changes may be explained by comparisons of ICHPPC-1 and ICHPPC-2 classifications. (A detailed listing of the differences between the two classifications is available from the authors.)

The second version of the International Classification of Health Problems in Primary Care is an important improvement of an instrument which has become extremely valuable to primary care

physicians through the world. It should become a universal replacement for ICHPPC-1. The authors feel that the problems that inevitably arise with conversion from one classification to another will be minimized by the use of this conversion code.

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
